# WHO WE SERVE RESCUED CHILD SOLDIERS & CHILDREN ORPHANED BY WAR

100,000 children abducted & 6 million orphaned by war in DR Congo & Uganda



Avg age at abduction. Avg age of a 6th grader.



Avg time captive – exposed to violence, trauma, & loss.

Decades of war have orphaned 6 million children and forced 100,000 more into slavery. Children as young as 7 are kidnapped and forced to fight in rebel armies. Psychologically tortured and brainwashed — children are enslaved, forced to fight, and forced to kill.

Many are forced to participate in violence against their own families and communities. Still more are abducted and abused, becoming victims of rape and sexual violence.

Those fortunate enough to escape or be released are left with deep and enduring emotional scars as a result of what they've seen and been forced to do. Many are unable to return home because they have either lost or been rejected by their families.



Fourteen year old Shalom was abducted at gunpoint by rebel fighters. Taken from his family and home, it would be years before Shalom could return. A story far too common in DR Congo, Shalom was enslaved by the rebels and forced to be a child soldier — forced to commit horrific acts of violence. But this would not be the end of his story.

After being rescued by the UN peacekeepers, Shalom was brought to The Peace Lives Center — an Exile International rehabilitation center. With time and the help of counselors and mentors, we have seen God work miracles in Shalom.

#### "I give glory to God for saving me until this day... I thank Jesus for saving my life." — Shalom

Since graduating from Exile's rehabilitation and leadership programs, Shalom is thriving! A recent university graduate, Shalom is pursuing his dream of helping others. Shalom is now an Exile leader — leading an Exile rehabilitation center in the very community from which he was once taken.

Few are better equipped to lead Exile's programs than young men and women like Shalom. Because of Shalom and others like him, Exile developed a training and equipping model for program graduates who are now successfully replicating the leadership programs that restored their lives.

In the past year, 16 new care programs were launched by El graduate-leaders — providing over 700 more children with the care they need to overcome and thrive! In 2020, 29 of Exile's 38 care programs were led by graduate-leaders... with even more launching in 2021!

These graduates are the embodiment of disciples making disciples — not stopping with their own healing, but sharing Christ's restoration and hope with others.

Formerly child soldiers, these young men and women are leaders for peace with the potential to transform their nation.

# ART-FOCUSED TRAUMA CARE

#### Expressive therapies provide a medium for children to process emotions & experiences they do not yet have the words to share.

Trauma can disrupt the language centers of the brain — making it difficult to express oneself to begin healing wounds of trauma.

Therapeutic programs incorporating music, dance, drama, and art provides war-affected children with avenues to share their stories — pain, loss, hopes, and dreams in a way that bypasses verbal language. Externalizing traumas is an integral and empowering step in each child's journey of healing and recovery.

Processing their stories with caregivers and peers, children rebuild a sense of connection and normalcy once lost to extreme physical and emotional traumas.

# **OUR APPROACH**

#### **Christ-Centered & Holistic**

Fostering healing and hope through rehabilitative care programs addressing the needs of the spirit, mind, and body — child survivors of war are finding new life in Christ!

#### **Art-Focused Trauma Care**

Music, dance, drama, and art provide a safer outlet for child survivors of war to express and process their emotional wounds.

#### **Education**

Education enables children to move from surviving to thriving — empowering young men and women to escape poverty, to support families, and to develop their own communities.

#### Peacebuilding, Conflict Resolution, & Leadership Development

Conflict impacts all our lives. In a region known for conflict, El is empowering the next generation of influencers with the tools needed to overcome conflict and lead communities towards peace.

#### **Graduate-Led Replication**

Every year, El is training and empowering more program graduates to launch care programs in their communities. These graduates and their influence are vital to ending cycles of violence and poverty throughout the region.

# **GRADUATE-LED REPLICATION**

#### 29 of 38 Care Programs Led by Program Graduates

Every year, Exile trains and equips more program graduates to launch rehabilitative care programs in their communities. These graduates and their influence are vital to ending cycles of violence and poverty throughout these regions.

Focusing efforts on replication driven through graduate-led programs — healing and hope are spreading at exponential rates in previously unreachable communities!

# FROM SURVIVORS TO LEADERS

#### Lives are being transformed & these young leaders are bringing healing to their own communities.

Former child soldiers — now healed, trained, and equipped leaders — are bringing healing and hope to recently rescued child soldiers in their communities. Program graduates who were once orphaned and on the street are now ministering to children orphaned by war.

Not only are they passionate — they are capable! They are successfully replicating the care programs that restored their lives.

With God's help and through these empowered young men and women — good news is spreading and communities are being transformed!

Dembers Story

I was four years old when I was abandoned by my parents because of the war and forced to live on the streets. The nights were very cold, and I was often without food. It was so challenging learning how to survive by myself. Often times older children on the streets would hurt me because I was so small. I was very sad and alone. I had no hope.

But I now know God was always with me. He saw me and sent a woman who made a living selling food in the community to rescue me. She saw I was being beaten by other children and knew they intended to initiate me into a street gang. She felt sorry for me and knew I needed help right away. This wonderful lady brought me to a local pastor. When he saw me, he knew my situation was very bad. The pastor brought me to Exile International. That's when my life changed for the better!

I received everything I needed! Exile International gave me shelter, food, medical care, and so much more. Exile also helped me to start healing from my inner wounds. I am now in fourth grade and love school. Dreaming of a future was something I could never do before, but now I want to become an engineer when I grow up! But while I am still a child, I will keep playing soccer — it's my favorite sport!

#### I thank God that He saw me and brought me peace!

# Provide 100,000 child survivors of war opportunities for healing & hope.


Empower each to become leaders, transform their communities, and end cycles of poverty and violence.

#### DECREASE IN PTSD SYMPTOMS

On average, youth experience a 78% decrease in PTSD symptoms within 24 months of entering Exile's programs.\*

\*Trauma recovery and progress is tracked on an on-going basis using the CRIES Test (a trauma severity test).
