- **614 Baptisms in 2025** — youth across Congo and Uganda proclaiming their faith in Christ, committing to make disciples.
 - **5,009 Youth in Care** — more children and young people are being reached than ever before, despite ongoing conflict in eastern DRC.
 - **Graduates Leading** — former beneficiaries are leading the very programs that helped them heal — bringing hope to their own communities.
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Pray for Our Teams in DR Congo

- **42 Programs Across Eastern DRC** — staff are leading programs in the midst of active conflict — pray for safety, courage, and rest for those serving daily in dangerous conditions.



- **Wisdom in Crisis** — pray for wisdom as teams navigate war, displacement, inflation, and supply chain challenges that threaten operations.
- **Graduate Leaders** — many of Exile's programs are now led by graduates of the program itself. Pray for these young leaders as they carry the weight of serving their own communities.

- **Staff Serving Youth** — lift up those serving young people in northern Uganda who carry the long aftermath of decades of war.

- **Leadership from Nashville** — pray for wisdom and discernment in leading the organization — the weight of nonprofit leadership is real.

- **Three Boards, One Mission** — Exile has boards in Congo, Uganda, and the United States — each playing a vital role in governance, protection, and accountability.

- **Future Leaders for Peace** — pray that these young people would become the leaders for peace they are being equipped to be.
